



Deacon Selection Process

- The person nominating and the person being nominated must both be members of the church.
- The Nominator will make their nomination known to an elder, in person.
- The Nominator will answer questions regarding how well they know Nominee and why they think Nominee is biblically qualified to serve as a Deacon.
- From this point, if Nominator desires to continue forward with their nomination and the Elder's agree, the Nominee will be notified.
- If Nominee desires to follow through with their nomination, he (if married, along with His wife) will be asked to participate in a class dealing with the qualifications, role and responsibilities of a Deacon and his wife.
- Once the class has been completed and Nominee (if married, along with His wife) has a desire to continue through the process, by recommendation of the Elders, the Nominee will be set aside for one year to begin serving in that role.
- The church will be notified of the Nominee and of the purpose for the "setting aside" of one year.
- Upon successfully completing one year of serving in this role, the church will officially affirm the Nominee as a Deacon of the church.
